### Internationellt internat: Reaching out, getting published

Den 17–19 september hålls FS internationella internat på Bäckaskog Slott på temat "Reaching out, getting published". Fyra utländska forskare är inbjudna: Martina Kessel (Universitat Bielefeld), Stuart Carroll (University of York), Mary Hilson (University College of London) och Marcel van den Linden (IISH Amsterdam). As an early modernist, I really enjoyed hearing about the work of students working on medieval and modern topics, from Kerstin Hundabl's engaging presentation on the Valdemarian kings, to Emma Hilborn's fascinating work on politics and romanticism in 'Brand'. Many themes were covered: histories of science, religion, politics, and emotions, to name only a few. I also found it really useful, not only to listen to different styles of presentation, but to be given feedback from students using a wide variety of

approaches. I learned a lot!

One of the highlights of the conference was a group trip to Dalby, where – thanks to a fascinating tour from Professor Stephan Borgehammer – we learned about the rich history of the Holy Cross Abbey, one of the oldest churches in Sweden. On the last day, we were lucky enough to be shown round Lund Cathedral.

During what might have been the most beautiful days of May, Forskarsskolan showed both itself and perhaps also Skåne from its very best side as we hosted a conference with international guests at beautiful Häckeberga manor. Visiting were about twenty doctoral students from the department of history at York University, under the supervision of Craig Taylor. The conference began already on Tuesday eve with good food together with our newfound colleagues.

On the Wednesday morning the sessions of presentation begun, seven in total. Each doctoral student had prepared a presentation of her thesis project of about ten minutes, whereafter ten minutes was provided for questions and reflections. The time given was of course too short for any deeper reasoning, but it was sufficient for a more general orientation in the research projects of the others. Many valuable connections were made, and the breadth of

our gathered expertise was fascinating: from the high middle ages up until almost today. It was noticed that many of the students from York had subjects connected to religious matters, which was very suited to the excursions made.

On the Thursday afternoon we all travelled by bus to picturesque Dalby church, before the night was spent in Lund. The end of the conference was then yet again another church-visit, this time in the Dome of Lund, on Friday morning, after which we all departed. Hopefully this conference meant the beginning of a fruitful future cooperation, and plans were mentioned during the conference not only to continue the cooperation with the British, but also try to make further connections to Germany. The work of internationalization seems to be happening right now!
